

Introduction


This document provides users with essential tasks associated with Wordfast Pro (WFP) and assumes you are already familiar with the interface and basic software functions. Use the online help for more details.

Translate a File

Save your work often by clicking Save on the File tab or by pressing Ctrl+S.

To translate a file:

1. On the Project Files tab, select a file and click Translate File.



- (Optional) On the Translation tab, copy all tags in the source segment to the target segment. Refer to <u>Copy All</u> <u>Tags</u>.
- 3. Select a target segment and enter the translation.

4. Click **Next Segment** or press **Alt+Down** to update the TM, move down one target segment, and leverage next segment content.

Chain Files

To combine multiple files and view them as a single file, use **Chain Files**. For example, if you are translating or reviewing ten files with ten segments each, you can temporarily chain them into a single file of 100 segments. This is particularly useful with duplicate or similar content among files.



You cannot export or save chained files as a single TXLF file.



You can open and work on a single chained file or multiple sets of chained files in the **TXLF Editor** view. Each chained file displays on its own tab.

To chain files:

1. On the Project Files tab, select a set of files, then click Chain Files.



Use Shift+Click to select sequential files or Ctrl+Click to select individual files.

The chained file opens in **TXLF Editor** with a default file name of Chained Files 1. Each file in the chain starts with a segment ID of 1 and ends with a file divider. Following segments in the file display a sequential number located in the **ID** column.

2. Click in a segment.

The file name changes from the chained name to the source file name of the active segment.

4. Click Save on the File tab to save the chained file.

The segments are saved in the chained file and restored to their original files without the chained format.

Copy All Tags

Use **Preferences > General Preferences > Tags** to configure tags as full-sized or shortened.

To copy all tags:

- 1. In TXLF Editor, open a file.
- 2. On the Edit tab, click Copy All Tags.

All copied tags display at the location of the cursor. Reorder them to reflect the source content order using the drag-and-drop or copy-and-paste technique.

3. Select **Segment** or **Document** from the drop-down menu.

Segment or **Alt+A** Copy only the tags for the selected segment to the target.

Document or **Alt-Shift+P** Copy all tags for the entire document.

All tags are copied to the segment or document.

Find and Replace Content

Use Find/Replace to search for and replace text in translated content.

To find and replace content in a file:


- 1. In TXLF Editor, click the Edit tab.
- 2. Click Find/Replace.



3. On the **Find/Replace** dialog, click in the **Find what** field, and then enter your search text or select it from the drop-down list.

4. (Optional) Click \checkmark and \land to expand and collapse the panel for additional options.



- 5. Click Find Next to move through all instances of the content.
- 6. (Optional) Click Reading Highlight to highlight all instances of the content in all open files.

7. (Optional) To replace characters or words, click the down arrow on the sidebar, then click in the **Replace with** field and enter a replacement.

8. (Optional) Select the direction of the search and any further options.



You cannot use the **Whole Words Only** search option when entering multiple words or punctuation in either search field.

9. (Optional) Click the desired action: Replace, Replace All, Find Next, or Close.

The content you found has been replaced with the new content.

Review a File

To review a file:

1. In the Project List view, double-click a project.



Projects with a single file automatically open in TXLF Editor view.

2. In **TXLF Editor**, review the source segment and the target translation, then make changes to the **Target** segment as needed.

Verify that all tags in the **Source** segment are in the corresponding location within the **Target** segment.

- 3. (Optional) Click Find/Replace to search for and replace repeated content. Refer to Find and Replace Content.
- Click Next Segment or press Alt+Down to update the TM, move down one segment, and leverage the next segment from the TM.

Save your work often by pressing **Ctrl+S** or clicking **Save** on the **File** tab.

Save a File

As you work on a file, frequently save your changes to a local folder .

To save your work:

- 1. Click the File tab, if you are not already on it.
- 2. In TXLF Editor, click either Save or a Save Options action.

Save File As Translated Select to save the active file to a local folder.

Save Select to save the active file to a local folder with the existing file name.

Save As Select to save the active file to a local folder under a different name.
